

6. Wind Turbine Walk

6km (nearly 4 miles).

This walk can be started from Kings Langley Station or from Primrose Hill Recreation Ground Car Park. This parking facility is for users of the recreation ground and walkers only.

From Kings Langley Station:

Turn right along Station Road for 400m and right into Egg Farm Lane. This is a private road, but also a public footpath. Go under the railway bridge and follow the road uphill past the wind turbine. Cross the bridge over the M25 and follow the road, which then turns into a track after about 300m. Take the footpath right, signposted to Bedmond Road, turn left along the field edge and left again past Parsonage Farm (the former Ovaltine Dairy Farm). Cross the M25 via the footbridge (2 stiles) and at the bottom of the hill turn left onto Sheppey's Lane.

Follow this for just over a kilometre, through some trees, then turn right downhill and then uphill to Toms Lane. Turn left down the lane, under the railway bridge, then cross Primrose Hill and go along Water Lane, turn left along the canal towpath☆. Go under 2 bridges and up a set of steps on the right, cross over the canal by the footbridge and follow the path round to the right and then left, over another footbridge and back to Station Road.

From Primrose Hill:

Take the footpath that runs along the edge of the recreation ground to the canal. Turn left onto the towpath and join the walk at ☆.
